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Re-Imagine Research!

A few words from Ian Rentsch, who took the reins at Clinerion as our new CEO at the beginning of April:



Dear Clinerion Community,

As I come to the end of my second month in the company, I wanted to share with you some thoughts about the challenges in the industry and how Clinerion is **Re-Imagining Research** and supporting patients around the world by getting drugs to market faster.

Clinical trials are becoming more complex: inclusion/exclusion criteria are increasing; meanwhile, industry benchmarks show that 80% of studies are delayed - these delays are very often related to recruitment. Half of sites don't meet their enrolment targets and 60% of trials end up needing an amendment to "fix" the issue of trying to find eligible patients. All of which costs time and a lot of money but, most importantly, delays time to market. At Clinerion, we are **Re-Imagining Research** using a real-time, real patient, real-world data-driven approach based on access to anonymized electronic medical records in our global site network to help master these industry challenges and bring drugs to market faster. Our value proposition is centered on "real-world data-driven planning and design", doing it right the first time to avoid future protocol amendments, followed by identifying the right country and site strategy. Lastly, one of our key competitive advantages is getting sponsors to the "right" eligible patients matching the protocol criteria, who will then be identified by the site and enrolled into the study.

I am very excited about the upcoming trends around virtual trials, leveraging technology and innovation in research to help patients around the world. Clinerion is part of this! **Re-Imagine Research!**
